The Pasquotank County Library shall not accept gifts of materials or donations of art work, furniture, etc. with special conditions or restrictions imposed by the donor such as separate shelving, display in a particular place or manner, guaranteed acquisition or permanent retention. The library is happy to provide a written acknowledgment of donations, but cannot legally appraise the value of materials. Most donated items not added to the collection are made available to the public through the Friends of the Library book sales.

Please do NOT donate items with missing covers or water, dirt, scribble, or mold damage.

We do NOT accept periodicals, encyclopedias, textbooks, Reader's Digest, VHS, or cassettes.
